Roles and responsibilities

Agora Secretariat

The Agora Secretariat is responsible for the overall success of Agora. It ensures that the direction of Agora is in line with its charter. The secretariat will allocate appropriate resources to Agora activities, agree key milestone dates and hold accountable each working party.

Working parties

Working parties are responsible for delivery of Agora's vision.

Working parties must ensure that Agora activities are developed within the milestones dates set by the leadership group. Most of the effort will come from delivering the activity.

The working parties are chaired by a nominated working party member and report directly to the leadership group.

Working party members

Working party members are responsible for task completion within a working party and have the collective responsibility for a working party's success. Tasks include:

- pursuing tasks and parties that can contribute to developing the activity
- Facilitate the ongoing development of the activity by using their organisation's resources or the resources of their professional network

Most of the effort will come from creating and driving activity

Melbourne Citymission

Melbourne Citymission was the catalyst of the Agora. It is neither the owner nor the leader of the Agora. Agora is led by the Leadership group.

It is one of the four resource supporters of the Agora, along with the Victorian Government, Ernst and Young and the Helen Macpherson Smith Trust.

It has committed to providing Secretariat support to the Leadership Group.

MCM is also a member of the Agora like other organisations and individuals.

MCM is the fund holder and is responsible for reporting progress to the other funding partners

Agora membership

The Agora membership is the active support base for Agora. Where there is an appropriate skills match, members will be invited to participate in working groups. Members will also be invited to Agora forums to better understand the working parties and to provide working parties with relevant input.

The Nous Group

The role of Nous is as much catalyst as facilitator. That is the role is to catalyse action as well as to facilitate discussion. The role requires Nous to:

- 1. To work with the Agora leadership group in clearly defining the scope of the Agora, and formulating the agenda and work plan
- 2. Facilitate, design and document the Agora working parties and 2006 conference
- 3. Help to promote and connect the idea of the Agora to attract a broader set of members
- 4. Provide support for the working groups
- 5. Assist working group to drive forward their activities.
