LIMURRU NEIGHBOURHOOD PARENTS' & CHILDREN'S CENTRE

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE CENTRE

LIMURRU is a neighbourhood centre in Fitzroy, sponsored by the Brotherhood of St. Laurence.

The aim is to provide for a range of the needs of young families in Fitzroy in an integrated manner, which contributes to an improved quality of life for those families.

In doing this, activities operate in 3 broad areas:-

- (a) Child Care sessional day care, occasional care, and emergency care.
- (b) Family Activities e.g., family camps, family picnics, etc.
- (c) Adult Activities e.g., sewing, cooking, market trips, etc.

Parent involvement in the planning and organisation of family and adult activities is encouraged to the maximum extent possible.

The centre is particularly oriented toward the needs of non-working families, and providing opportunities for support and personal growth for both children and their parents.
