

## Drycleaners' Clothing Appeal

Melbourne members of the Australian Institute of Drycleaning are again planning to conduct their Clothing Appeal for the Brotherhood.

During the month of February, members of the Institute, who operate over 300 drycleaning outlets, will dryclean free of charge all donations of good quality clothing given to them for the Brotherhood.

Last year's appeal proved to be an outstanding success. The Institute calculated that 2000 garments laid cuff to cuff, or collar to hem, would

constitute a mile of clothing. During last February participating members collected over 5000 garments for the Brotherhood, which was estimated to be 2.4 miles of clothing.

Members of the Drycleaning Institute are hoping that the 1985 appeal will be even more successful than last year's. The appeal will conclude with 'Brotherhood Week' at the Chadstone Shopping Centre from February 25 to March 1.

To the Brotherhood —

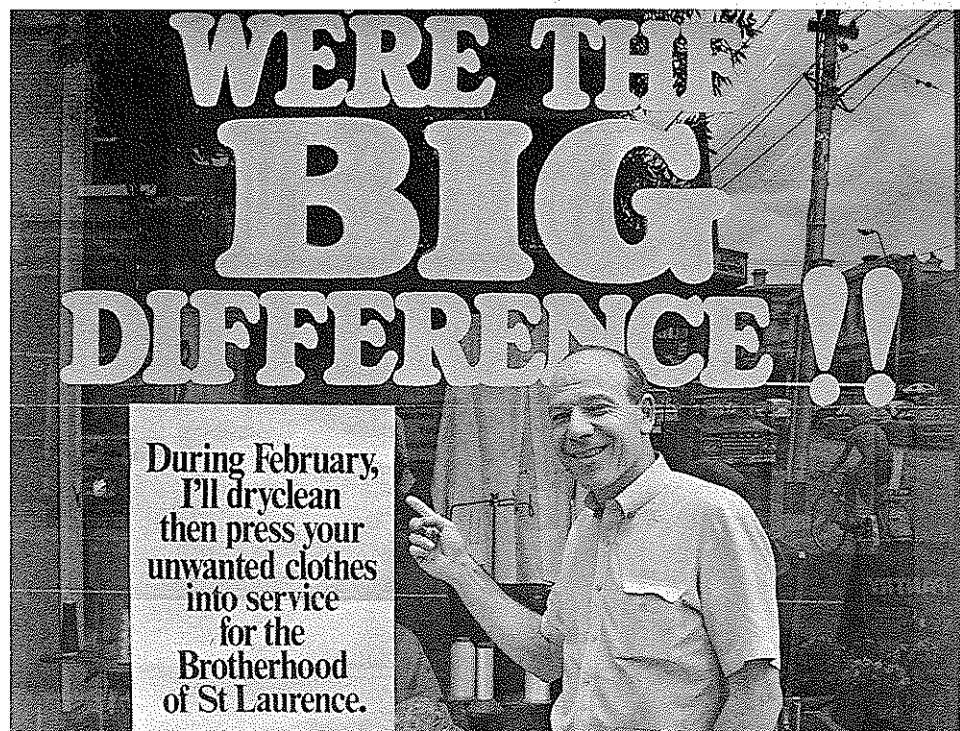
It gives me pleasure to enclose a donation towards the continuation of your work.
